

A message from Congresswoman Carolyn Maloney 12th Congressional District

In the weeks since I held an Oversight hearing to examine our nation's COVID-19 preparedness, the number of positive cases in New York and across the country have soared. With all the uncertainty and financial strain created by the coronavirus crisis, I want to share what I am doing to help you weather this storm.

Congress has passed two massive emergency packages, one being the Families First Coronavirus Response Act, to help American families. As we negotiate the terms of the third stimulus, I am fighting to ensure it prioritizes the needs of workers, families, and small businesses who have been devastated by this crisis and delivers urgent financial assistance.

No American should worry about keeping a roof over their head during this outbreak. That's why I fought for, and won, a moratorium on foreclosures and evictions for more than 70% of homeowners with mortgages backed by the federal government or by Fannie Mae and Freddie Mac.

As the number of COVID-19 cases in New York continues to rise, so does the urgent need for ventilators and medical supplies. I led the entire New York Congressional delegation in requesting 20,000 ventilators from the national stockpile to help New York. I also requested \$4 billion in emergency funding to keep the MTA fulling functioning so medical professionals can travel and continue servicing New Yorkers in need.

These are unprecedented and difficult times, but I know New York City will continue to demonstrate strength and resilience.
